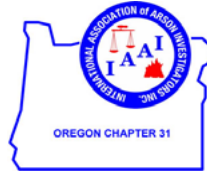

## BASIC TRAINING CURRICULUM

*Basic Fire Investigation*, presented by Jim Allen and Joe Konefal:

A 24 hour course on Basic Fire Investigation based on NFPA 921 that will include Scientific Methodology, Fire Behavior (including plumes, entrainment and ventilation), ignition, fire patterns, evidence, curriculum vitae and testifying. Discussion will allow for particular problem issues that the class may have.

**It is recommended that you bring your NFPA 921, 2008 edition for reference and highlighting of problem areas for the investigator.**

This class is widely regarded as the course that has something to provide for everyone regardless of their level of training.

Jim Allen has many years experience in fire, police and community college environments. He has worked for the US Forest Service, California Department of Forestry, San Joaquin County Sheriff's Office, California State Fire Marshal, and Allen Hancock College. Jim has investigated approximately 800 fires and has testified as an expert witness in California Courts and the US District Court—Central District of Columbia.

Joe Konefal is retired from the California Office of State Fire Marshal as Supervising Investigator.
